1. Combat support service of troops

DEFINITON

Combat service support is a subset of military logistics. Combat service support is more limited in depth than logistics, as it primarily addresses those factors directly influencing combat operations.











2. Combat support of field artillery troops

DEFINITON

Combat support refers to units that provide fire support and operational assistance to combat elements. Combat support units provide specialized support functions to combat units in the areas of chemical warfare, combat engineering, intelligence, security, and communications.











2. Combat support of field artillery troops

The combat support branches are the:

- Chemical Corps
- Corps of Engineers (these are units involved with civil engineering, not combat engineering)
- Military Intelligence Corps
- Military Police Corps
- Signal Corps
- Army Aviation (e.g., Battlefield Reconnaissance, Signals Intelligence, and Assault Helicopter units)











3. Security of field artillery troops
