#### 1. The field artillery command system

#### **Definition**

Command and control, or C2, in a military organization is the exercise of authority and direction by a properly designated commanding officer over assigned and attached forces in the accomplishment of the mission. The term may also refer to command and control systems within a military system.











#### 2. Command and control processes

Immediately after OPORD or FRAGO

The Military Decision Making Process: MDMP

- Receipt of Mission
- Mission Analysis
- Course of action (COA) Development
- COA Analysis (aka Wargaming)
- COA Comparison
- COA Approval
- Orders Production











#### 3. Documents for command

OPORD is formatted to organize an operation into five easily understood paragraphs:

- Situation,
- Mission,
- Execution,
- Sustainment (formerly Service and Support, currently referred to as Admin & Logistics by the US Marine Corps), and
- Command and Control.
