- 1. Go to nursery school / kindergarten
- **2. Go to a primary school** what subjects? (maths, Czech, art, music, crafts, national history and geography, PT...)
- 3. Study at a secondary school / US: high school

(what kind? grammar school, secondary technical school, secondary business school, vocational school ...)

(what subjects? – the humanities / the arts – the sciences; programming, typing etc...)

- entrance examination
- school-leaving exam

## 4. University of Defence

- make an important decision to go to the UoD and to choose the branch (motivation, family tradition...)
- **entrance examination** (what subjects?, written or oral?, difficult or easy?, at the first attempt, accepted/admitted after an appeal...)
- **basic training** (length, skills and activities, problems to get used to military life...)
- being undergraduate (military life as compared to a secondary school student's life, duties, difficulties, advantages + disadvantages - accommodation, food, books...)

- **Postgraduate studies:** (requirements, entrance exams? how many years of practical experience needed?)

**doing a Master's degree** (length, topic of dissertation, getting a Master's degree (Ing.) ...)

**doctoral study** (branch, thesis – topic, research, ...)

- Studying English at the UoD (how many lessons per week, teachers, course books, activities, exams: end-of-term credit tests (graded/ marked?) satisfied with the progress that you made? using your English outside the classroom, the Internet, books)
- **5. Plans for future** (going on a mission abroad? further education? ...)
