Corrected Report (one possibility)

Incident Report

This report gives my account of the incident involving 2Lt Sam Bourque. It occurred while he was playing hockey in the Base tournament on the evening of Friday 9 Nov around 2030 hours.

The accident happened five minutes into our first game of the tournament. At the end of his first shift, 2Lt Bourque was coming off the ice for a line change. As he was skating towards our players' box, he lost his balance, tripped, fell backwards and slid feet first into the boards. This resulted in an injury to his right foot. In pain, he managed to get up with the help of a teammate, Steve Côté. He then limped back and forth behind the players' bench. Shortly afterward, he went to the dressing room. During the first intermission, I borrowed Capt Bates's keys and used his truck to take 2Lt Bourque to the hospital. I was accompanied by Jean Davis, Bourque's friend. I left Bourque with the MIR staff and then returned to the game.

It is important to stress that the accident occurred during a stoppage in play and that 2Lt Bourque was not bumped or hit by anyone as he fell. It was unpreventable and uninduced. It was just bad luck.

The hockey game in question was the first of a tournament held on the Base during the weekend of 9, 10 and 11 Nov. It was organized and officiated by the Base PERI staff.
